

MEMORANDUM TO THE CONFERENCE:

I have been mulling over these cases with a view to possibly changing my vote and breaking the four to four tie. I conclude, however, that I will stand on my initial vote. Unless someone else changes the vote, I would like to see these cases come down next Monday.

I recommend that No. 79-700 - Walter Fleisher Co. v. County of Los Angeles be disposed of by the attached per curiam order. With regard to No. 78-1577 - Sears, Roebuck & Co. v. County of Los Angeles, which was argued last Term and held over but not re-argued this Term, I suggest that we enter a separate order on the Order List stating: "The judgment is affirmed by an equally divided Court. Justice Stewart took no part in the consideration or decision of this case."
