

MEMORANDUM TO THE CONFERENCE

Re: 82-271 - Chardon v. Soto

The last footnote in my first draft in this case was inadvertently omitted from subsequent drafts and from the slip opinion, and accordingly the last few footnotes are misnumbered. The omitted footnote illustrates a point made in text about statutes of limitations in the antitrust area, and I would like to reinsert it in the version of the opinion that will appear in the U.S. Reports. Attached are the footnote itself (pp. 11-12 of the first draft) and a marked up copy of the appropriate pages of the slip opinion, showing how the last few footnotes would be relocated and renumbered to rectify the error. I do not think these changes would affect the dissent, and I assume there will be no objection.
